Welcome to WAVE (Women Against Violence Education)



All people in Aotearoa have the right to live violence-free, but for many women in relationships this right is denied. Unfortunately, many women in New Zealand are subjected to physical, psychological and/or sexual abuse.

This is never justified!

Fortunately, education and support such as that available from Family Works Northern's Women Against Violence Education (WAVE) programme can help women to increase awareness and build strength in order to improve their situations.

WAVE is a Ministry of Justice approved programme for women who have been or still are in abusive relationships and are interested in making more positive choices for themselves and their children.

How we can help

The WAVE programme is unique to Family Works Northern. It is specifically designed for women who have experienced family violence and is delivered by authorised, qualified female facilitators.

WAVE consists of a 10-session programme that provides information to women about the dynamics of family violence. It facilitates an opportunity for women to speak freely about their experiences whilst at the same time promoting effective safety planning.

The programme primarily involves group discussion with relevant DVDs incorporated into the sessions.



Who we are



WAVE is a comprehensive programme that covers a wide range of topics.

It has five main themes:

- Education about violence in a wider sense
- Education to support the belief that people are responsible for their own violence (i.e. that victims aren't responsible for it)
- Encouragement for women to take responsibility for themselves and their children (based on an understanding of the effects of domestic violence)
- Support to develop a sense of entitlement to all basic rights
- Support to build self-acceptance and self-respect
